**Day:** Fridays

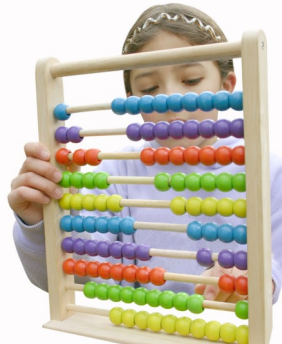
**Time:** Session 1 8.45am-10.50am

Session 4 8.45am-2pm

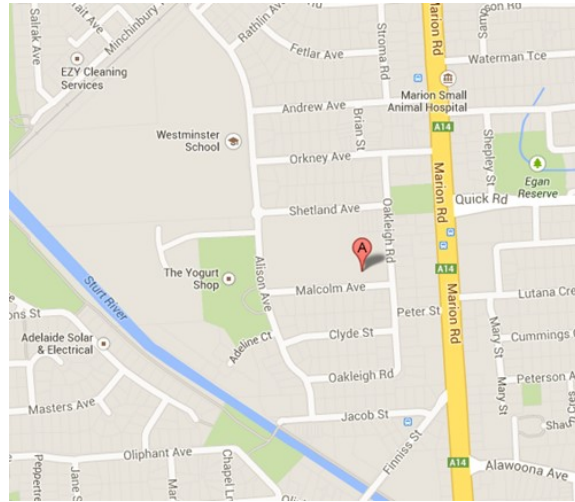
**When:** Weeks 5,6,7 & 8 of Term 4

The program allows staff to get to know you

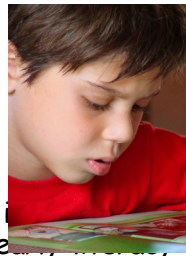
- find individual interests
