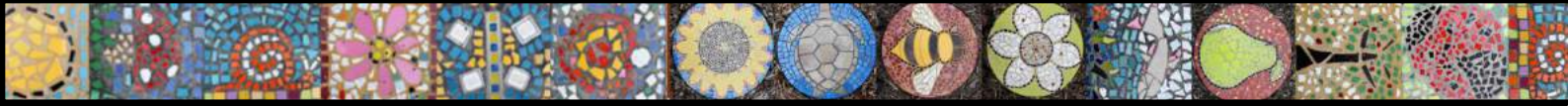

Come and meet new parents and have a quiet cuppa and chat.*

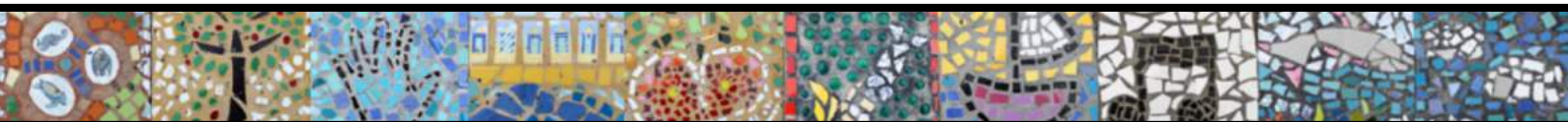
PLAYGROUP
