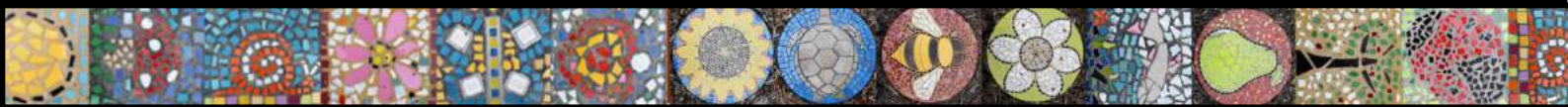

*Our Playgroup is all set to go for an exciting, busy year of play, fun and adventure.*

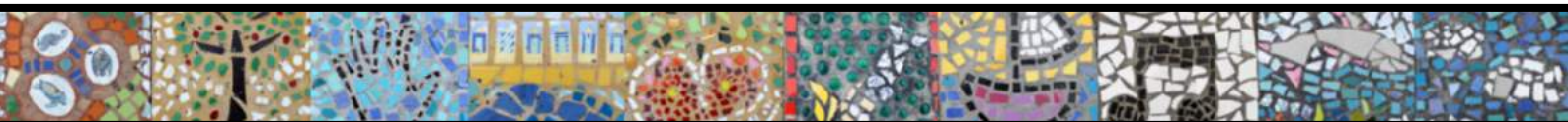
*Parents or carers with preschool children are very welcome to come on a weekly or casual basis.*
