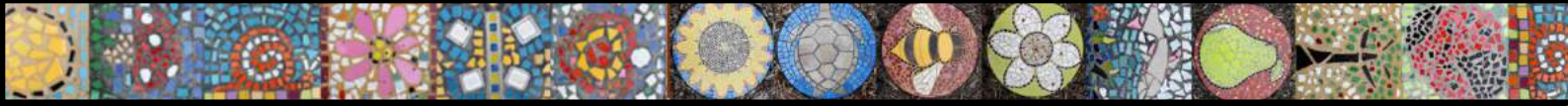

## WHAT'S NEW IN TERM 2

Next week you will receive a summary of your family and emergency contact details which we request you review and update as needed. Please return these whether there are changes or not. This week we have needed to contact families and have found several phone numbers out of date. In week 7 we will be commencing an electronic roll marking system called RollMarker which will more closely track our attendance information. This system is compatible with our School Star app and our MGM Outreach system that enables us to send messages to families. We encourage you to download the School Star app as we will increasingly use this and our FaceBook account to communicate events that are coming up.

This term, all schools are required to collect information about the numbers of students that are provided with adjustments to their learning under the Disability Discrimination Act (1992) and Disability Standards of Education. This data is used as the basis for national funding. Under the model the definition of disability is broad and includes learning difficulties, health and mental health conditions. If your child is identified for inclusion in the Collection, the required information will be included in this year's data collection.
