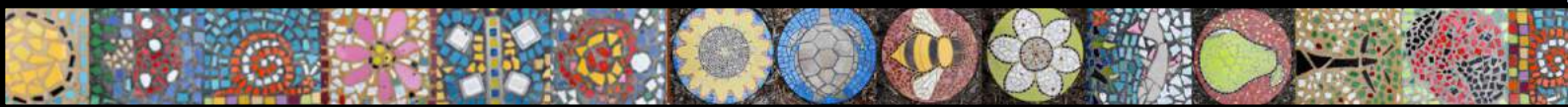

## FUN RUN COLOUR DAY

We're holding the *School Fun-Run* as a major fundraising event this year! The event will be held on the last day of Term 3, **FRIDAY 27 SEPTEMBER 2019**. Over the past few years, we have raised funds to go towards replacing the old 'tree house' and repairs to other playground equipment as well as buying and planting trees to provide additional shade for the play area. However, as a result of getting quotes and researching costs for new equipment, the Governing Council, in consultation with Principal Ms Ross and the Grounds Committee have approved the re-development of the whole playground!

This is a huge project that will be phased over 3 years at the cost of approximately \$100,000.00. In the hallway near the front first aid room you will see photos and plans of the design concept and we look forward to sharing more details with you as things progress.

Keep your eyes peeled for the sponsorship forms which will be sent home with your child next week. Once you do this and raise at least \$1 online, you will be entered into the \$20,000 Ultimate Family Experience! #### SCHOOL PHOTOS

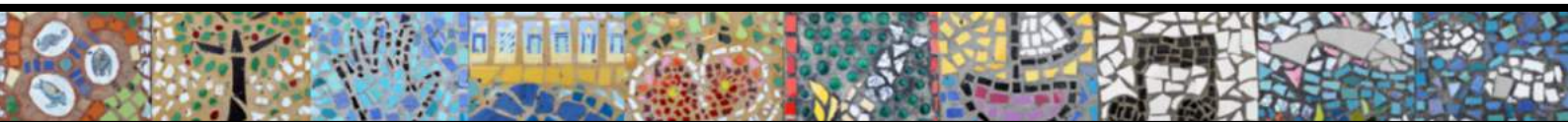
