Vacation Care Information

Our Vacation care program offers a range of supervised recreational activities which encourage children to interact with friends, learn life skills, problem solve and be challenged by new experiences in a safe and relaxed environment.

Program

Regular activities are available every day. These include outside play (weather permitting), computers, Wii, arts and crafts, cooking, music and dress-ups. We also offer excursions and incursions in the program.

Times

Vacation care is open from 7am-6:15pm. On excursion days children must be at the centre no later than one hour prior to departure. All staff will be on duty at the excursion so the centre will be closed during this time.

Bookings

Booking forms must be completed and returned by Friday the 20th August to receive the early bird rate of \$48 per child per day (less for families with child care benefit). Bookings after this date will be subject to available spaces and a fee of \$53 per child per day (also less for families with child care benefit).

To ensure correct staffing ratios can be maintained please complete booking forms as soon as possible. They are available in the OSHC room, the front office, on the school web site or by email.

To ensure your child/children's place for care including incursion/excursion days fees are required to be paid prior to the start of Vacation Care by Friday the 27th September. Please book early to avoid disappointment.

Full fees must be paid less CCS per child per day of care as booked and also incursion and excursion charges as per the program. If your account has outstanding fees for the prior Vacation Care program bookings will not be accepted.

Fees

Early bird rate \$48

Normal rate \$53

Excursion and Incursion days are non-refundable and all other days will require one week cancellation prior to care.

A late fee of \$2 per minute per child after 6:20pm and a further \$5 per minute after 6:30pm also applies.

Hot/wet weather

Some activities may need to be modified or rescheduled in extreme weather conditions (raining or the predicted maximum temperature is 36 degrees or over). We will inform families if there is a change in the program.

All children are required to wear Sunsmart clothing and appropriate footwear.

Food

The service provides breakfast until 8.30 am and an afternoon snack. Children will need to bring their own recess and lunch unless stated on the program (not cup noodles) and extra snacks for throughout the day. Drinking water will be provided but it is also recommended that the children bring their own drink bottle that can be topped up.

Vacation Care is a nut free zone as we have children with allergies in attendance.
