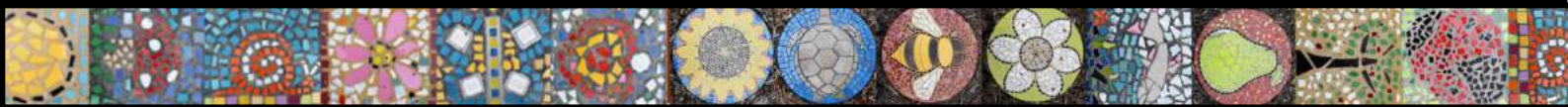

REVIEW, RENEW, PREPARE FOR 2020

Our External Review concluded Wednesday. Thank you to each of the parents and members of Governing Council who attended sessions with the panel. Your feedback forms part of the directives made by the review team and with Governing Council approval, will be implemented by us over the next three years.

Evidence of our impact on learning, including observations from the review and a recent visit by leaders of our Partnership schools, our students' assessment data (from NAPLAN and other sources) and analysis of our work during the year to implement our school improvement goals, will be used in our own internal review on the next Pupil Free Day. This determines changes to actions for current goals and implementation of new goals. These will be discussed and approved through Governing Council.

Thank you to families who have advised of their moving in 2020. We have a larger than usual number of new enrolments across some year levels and it is important to know where vacancies will occur.

We are now considering class structures for 2020. Parents who have requests for us to consider in regards to their child's placement are invited to put this in writing, addressed to Cheryl Ross. You will appreciate that we are limited in class structures by the number of students we have at particular year levels.



Hosting a visit by members of the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra who performed a piece written for children titled Miss Lily, was a wonderful opportunity for our students to see and hear a quality live performance. Our Y2-7 string instrument music students were fortunate to participate in a follow-up workshop with orchestra members. The school will be closed to enable staff to review 2019 and plan for next year to ensure strong progress of our school improvement agenda.

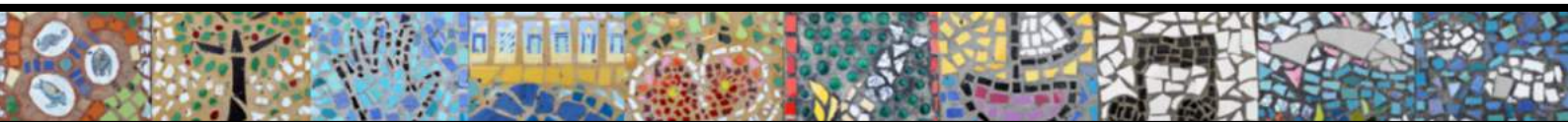
OSHC will be open and bookings are essential.
