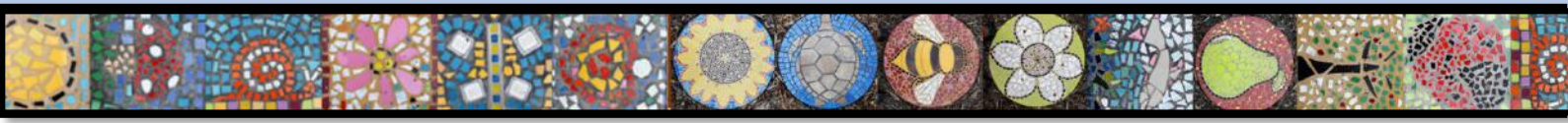

### Covid plans update

With one more week of Term 2 left, and recent advice from Government and Department for Education I can update our ongoing plans managing this virus.

**We have really appreciated your support through this period. We must remain vigilant against any outbreaks or second wave occurrences.**

**It is important that students and staff stay home if they are unwell.**

Parents can enter school grounds, maintaining social distancing in the yard and at gates and footpaths near the school.

The school is not open to use by the general public on playgrounds or play equipment, eg weekends or after school hours.

We can hold assemblies – but adults must maintain a safe distance and there must only be one person per 2 sq m in an enclosed space. This would mean that we would hold assemblies, but without parents, friends and relatives.

Visitors, service providers, and volunteers can enter school but must complete the site access form.

School age sport is beginning, again with restrictions relating to spacing, and contact, social distance for spectators.
