COVID MANAGEMENT - At the time of going to print we have the following aspects of a Covid management plan in place, based on advice from SA Health and the Department for Education.

Physical distancing for adults continues. No more than 1 person per 2 sq metre in an enclosed space. Adults to maintain a minimum social distance of 1.5 metres. *This applies to adults in the yard before and after school.*

Term 4 events, assemblies, Fun Run, Carols Night, Graduation Celebration will all be planned with these guidelines. More information will be made available as we get closer to the event itself.

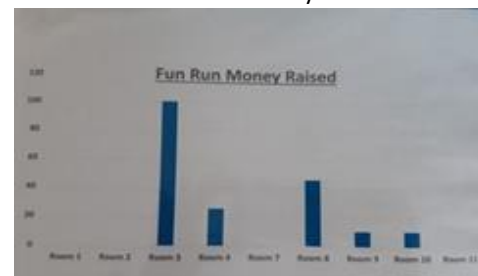
Site closure: Upon notification of a confirmed case to the Principal, all staff and parents will be notified and children will be picked up from school as soon as possible. The site will be thoroughly cleaned and contact tracing will take place. The site will only re-open on the advice of SAHealth.

Hygiene: Additional cleaning occurs during the day. Staff continue to remind students of safe, clean hygienic practices. Sanitising liquid and soap are provided, cough and sneeze etiquette is encouraged.

Sickness: We expect students and staff who are unwell, even with mild respiratory / cold symptoms to stay home. Seek medical advice and a test if required. If tested, do not return to school until a negative result is confirmed.

Main topic will be Material and Services charges for 2021.

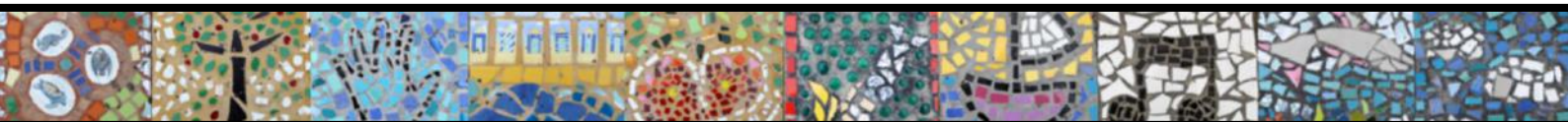
Otherwise known as 'Book fees'.

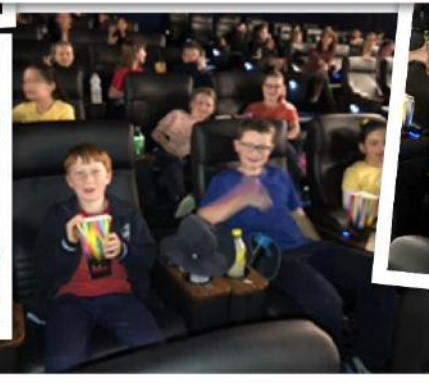
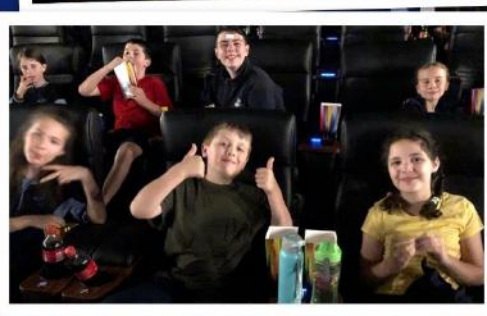
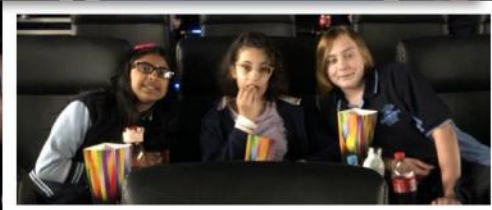
